Experience The South Carolina Marine Resources Center encompasses 78 acres of historic property located on James Island adjacent to the Charleston Harbor estuary. The Marine Center occupies land where the [historic Ft. Johnson](#) was once located, and where the first shots of the American Civil War were fired.

Today, the Marine Resources Center supports several state and federal research facilities on a modern campus that is largely maintained by the South Carolina Department of Natural Resources. The headquarters for the SCDNR's Marine Resources Division is located at the Marine Center along with a few staff from other divisions of the agency: College of Charleston's Grice Marine Laboratory, NOAA's Center of Coastal Environmental Health and Biomolecular Research, National Institute of Standards and Technology, and Hollings Marine Laboratory
